Who, When and What to Expect

The process is started by sending a backup from your current system to us. Our IT staff will port it into a usable format or have you create reports for our data entry group. They will determine if the data is in the correct fields and then use a best efforts attempt to establish fuel links and create kits and packages. Depending upon the complexity of the database and our experience with data from the system you are currently using, this process should take a week or two.

All customers including cash, account and rental "bad guys" are imported. Life-to-date income and other detail information is imported from most databases. All inventory including rental items, sales items and parts is imported with pricing and purchase price. Month-to-date, Year-to-date, Lifetime revenue and ROI are imported from most systems. Except for data from Point-of-Rental™ Legacy systems, active and historical contracts cannot be imported at the present time.
